Chief Justice Felipe Alfredo Fuentes Barrera



A Mexican lawyer who serves as Justice of the High Chamber of the Electoral Tribunal of the Federal Judiciary (TEPJF) since November 2016.

On 23 January 2019, he was appointed Chief Justice of the High Chamber.

Education

He earned his Degree in Law from the National Autonomous University of Mexico (1979-1983); a Judicial specialization from the Supreme Court of Justice of the Nation (SCJN), extension Veracruz (1994); a Master Degree in Protection Law from the *Instituto de Ciencias Jurídicas de Estudios Superiores* (Legal Science Graduate School) (2006); a Master Degree in Protection and Constitutional Law from the University of del Valle Toluca, with the thesis "Right to intimacy, need of constitutional regulation" (2011); a PhD in Constitutional Law from the Tepantlaton University (2012).

Professional experience

Felipe Alfredo Fuentes Barrera became part of the Federal Judiciary in 1991 as Secretary of the Third Collegiate Criminal Court and Second Collegiate Civil Court, both from the Seventh Circuit. Secretary of the First Collegiate Civil Court of the Third Circuit; Secretary of the Second Civil Collegiate Court of the First Circuit; Briefing Attorney at the Supreme Court of Justice of the Nation (1997).

He was appointed District Judge in November 1997, through an internal promotion. First District Judge in the State of Tabasco; Tenth and Twelfth District Judge in civil matters in the Federal District. Circuit justice appointed on September 18th, 2000, when winning the Fifth Competition for Internal promotion for the Appointment of Circuit Justices and endorsed on August 23, 2006.

He served as Chief Justice of the Fourteenth Collegiate Court in Administrative matters of the First Circuit. Upon recommendation of the Supreme Court of Justice of the Nation (SCJN), the Senate of the Republic elected him as Justice of the High Chamber of the Electoral Tribunal of the Federal Judiciary for an 8-year period starting his administration as of November 4th of the same year.



In addition to his judicial career, he has served as Solicitor and Chief of Legal Affairs Office at the Mexican Social Security Institute. Auditor of the Regulation and Consultation Department in the General Direction of Legal Affairs of the Public Education Secretariat; Deputy Director General of the General Direction of Complaints at the Secretariat of General Comptroller of the Federation and Legal assistant in several private law firms.

Teaching and academic experience

Professor in Constitutional Guarantees at the School of Law of the Xalapa University. Professor in Constitutional Guarantees and Human Rights at the School of Law of the Guadalajara University; Professor in Constitutional Process in Comparative Law and Constitutional State and Justice Systems at the Autonomous University of the State of Mexico (UAEM).

He has delivered courses in Amparo (Protection) and Civil and Civil Procedural Law at the Institute of the Federal Judiciary in Tabasco.

Is a Mexican lawyer who is acting as Justice of the High Chamber of the Electoral Tribunal of the Federal Judiciary (TEPJF) since November 2016.

She has a bachelor's degree in Law by the Autonomous University of Guadalajara (UAG), a master's degree in Education and Teaching by the International University of la Paz and is specialized in Electoral Justice and has a diploma in Electoral Law by the High Chamber of the Electoral Tribunal of the Federal Judiciary.

Justice Soto Fregoso has acted as Legal Advisor at the Local Executive Board of the Federal Electoral Institute (then IFE, now INE, in Spanish) in the state of Baja California 1994 and 1996-1997); Technician of the Federal Electoral Registry in the state of Jalisco (1995); Technician of Electoral Processes in the Local Executive Board of IFE in Baja California (1997-2003); Spokesperson of Electoral Capacitation and Civic Education of the second District Executive Board of IFE in the state of Campeche (January-April 2003) and in Baja California (2003-2007).

In 2007, she was appointed by the State Congress of Baja California as Justice of the State Electoral Tribunal of Baja California. Justice José Luis Vargas Valdez



Born in Mexico City on 5 December 1972. Mexican lawyer, Justice of the High Chamber of the Electoral Tribunal of the Federal Judiciary (TEPJF) since November 2016.

Education

He has a bachelor's degree in Law by the Autonomous Technological Institute of Mexico (ITAM, in Spanish), and a master's degree in Public Law by the Pompeu Fabra University in Barcelona, Spain. He is a PhD candidate in Public Law with a specialty in Constitutional Law with the dissertation "The profile of the Constitutional Judge: analysis of the guarantees of independence and impartiality". In 2005, he obtained the degree of Research Sufficiency and the Diploma of Advanced Studies awarded by the Spanish State.

Professional Experience

His professional development has been widely linked to electoral, constitutional and administrative law. He has been Adviser to an Electoral Counselor at the Federal Electoral Institute (IFE, 1996-2000); Legal Adviser at the Presidency at the IFE (2005-2006); Chief Clerk of the High Chamber of the TEPJF (2006-2007); and Head of Unit at the Center for Research and National Security (CISEN, 2007-2010). In 2010, he was appointed Head of the Specialized Prosecutor's Office for Electoral Offenses by the President of the Republic, with the level of Deputy Attorney General of the Republic (FEPADE, 2010-2012). From 2012 until 2016 he worked as a solicitor in his own firm.

At the proposal of the Supreme Court of Justice of the Nation, the Senate of the Republic elected him Electoral Justice of the High Chamber of the TEPJF for a period of 7 years, beginning his term on November 4, 2016. As a Justice, in addition to his jurisdictional work, he oversees the promotion and strengthening the international cooperation of the TEPJF, collaborating in the design of social communication strategies, and supervising the elaboration of jurisprudence and theses.

Teaching and Academic Experience

Justice Vargas Valdez has taught various courses, seminars and graduate classes in topics such as Electoral Law, Constitutional Law and Fundamental Laws, as well as National Security and Procurement of Justice. His teaching and academic activities have been carried out at the following academic institutions: El Colegio de México (ColMex), Legal Research Institute at the UNAM (IIJ-UNAM), Autonomous Technological Institute of Mexico (ITAM), National Institute of Public Administration (INAP), University of Veracruz (UV), University of Pompeu Fabra, University of Carlos III and Complutense University of Madrid.
